

## *John Sheffield*

### *Teacher of the Year Award*

The Northwestern Oklahoma State University Student Government Association, in order to honor the memory and ideas of the late honored professor, John Sheffield, establishes the John Sheffield Teacher of the Year Award, which will be presented annually at the Alumni Banquet.

To insure that his ideas and services will be remembered the recipient of the John Sheffield Award shall possess and exemplify the following qualities:

He/She should display his effectiveness to the student body by:

1. Showing a genuine enthusiasm for people
2. Courage to give himself/herself to others
3. Faith to trust in his/her honored profession

He/She should also display:

1. Service to college and country
2. Willingness to support the student body
3. Willingness to work
4. High professional standards
5. Characteristics of dependability

Applications will be distributed by the Student Government Association to the student body. The applications will then be returned by March 15<sup>th</sup>. The applications must be submitted with at least one letter of recommendation. The student submitting the application cannot also submit the letter of recommendation. Therefore each nomination will be made by at least two students.

In order to provide for the selection of a worthy recipient the Student Government Association shall establish a standing committee to select the said recipient. Composition of the committee will include, but not be limited to, seven Senators.

The standing committee will review the applications and shall nominate a list of five faculty members on campus and deliver the said list to the Student Government Association Senate by the first meeting in April for a vote by the Senate.

An estimate of fifty dollars (\$50) will be paid by the Student Government Association for the plaque to be presented to the recipient of the John Sheffield Teacher of the Year Award.
